3 – 4 minutes

Interlocutor In this part of the test, I'm going to give each of you a topic and I'd like you to talk about it on your own for about a minute. You also need to answer a question briefly about your partner's topic.

(Candidate A), it's your turn first. Here's your task.
Place Part 2 booklet, open at Task 2A, in front of Candidate A.

I'd like you to **talk about a language you are fluent in**. First, you have some time to think about what you're going to say.

Interlocutor

You should say:

- **what song it is**
- **who the singer(s) is/are**
- **where you heard this song**
- **reasons why you love this song**
