- **who he/she is**
- **how he / she looks like**
- **what you want to do when you meet him/her**
- **how having a role model affects teenagers**

Smart shopper

Part 3

4-5 minutes

Interlocutor	Now, I'd like you to talk about something together for about three minutes. The task will have two parts. In the first part, you will discuss something with each other for about two minutes. Then, in the second part, you will have another minute to make a decision together. All right? Let's begin with the discussion task. Smart shoppers always think carefully before they buy something. <i>Place Part 3 booklet, open at Task 3, in front of the candidates. Here are some ways to become a smart shopper</i> and a question for you to discuss. First, you have some time to look at the task.
Candidate A & B  approx. 20 seconds	<i>Allow candidates 20 seconds to prepare.</i>
Interlocutor	Now, talk to each other about the ways to become a smart shopper.
Candidate A & B  2 minutes	 <i>Back-up prompts to be used if necessary:</i> What do you think [candidate's name]? What about this [pointing to option]?
Interlocutor	Thank you. Now you have about a minute to decide together which is the best way to become a smart shopper.
Candidate A & B  1 minute	
Interlocutor	Thank you. (Can I have the booklet, please? <i>Retrieve Part 3 booklet.</i> You've been discussing the ways to become a smart shopper; now, let's hear your opinion on this. To what extent are students aware of the growing trend of unnecessary purchases and their impact? <i>Select any of the following prompts as appropriate:</i> Why do you think? Do you agree? How about you?
