*Answer all questions.***The Life and Teachings of Christ as contained in the Gospel according to Luke***Read the context passages below and answer the questions that follow.*

- 1 (a) *Then Jesus went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath he went as usual to the synagogue. He stood up to read the Scriptures.*
(Luke 4:16)
- (i) Name the book of the Scriptures which Jesus read from. [1 mark]
 - (ii) State what Jesus read from that book. [1 mark]
 - (iii) Immediately after reading the Scriptures, what did Jesus say to the people in the synagogue? [3 marks]
- (b) *The disciples went to Jesus and woke him up, saying, “Master, Master! We are about to die!”*
(Luke 8:24a)
- (i) What led the disciples to wake Jesus up? [2 marks]
 - (ii) Describe the miracle that Jesus performed in response to the statement above. [2 marks]
 - (iii) What does this miracle tells us about the power of Jesus? [1 mark]
- (c) *Zacchaeus hurried down and welcomed him (Jesus) with great joy. All the people who saw it started grumbling, “This man has gone as a guest to the home of a sinner!”*
(Luke 19:6 – 7)
- (i) State Zacchaeus’ occupation. [1 mark]
 - (ii) What did Zacchaeus promise to Jesus? [2 marks]
 - (iii) What was Jesus’ response to Zacchaeus’ promise. [2 marks]
- (d) *Then the women remembered his words, returned from the tomb, and told all these things to the eleven disciples and all the rest.*
(Luke 24:8 – 9)
- (i) Name the women who returned from the tomb. [1 mark]
 - (ii) What did the women see at the tomb? [2 marks]
 - (iii) What were the responses of the eleven disciples to the women’s report? [2 marks]

The Acts of the Apostles

Read the context passages below and answer the questions that follow.

2 (a) *As soon as Peter and John were set free, they returned to their group and told them what the chief priests and the elders had said. When the believers heard it, they all joined together in prayer to God: “Master and Creator of heaven, earth, and sea, and all that is in them!”* (Acts 4:23 – 24)

- (i) What warning did the chief priests and the elders give to Peter and John before setting them free? [1 mark]
- (ii) State two requests made by the believers in their prayer to God. [2 marks]
- (iii) What happened immediately after the believers prayed? [2 marks]

(b) *While Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit came down on all those who were listening to his message.* (Acts 10:44)

- (i) In whose home was Peter speaking? [1 mark]
- (ii) Identify one group of people who was present. [1 mark]
- (iii) What were the two actions of the listeners when the Holy Spirit came down on them? [2 marks]
- (iv) State the significance of this incident. [1 mark]

(c) *When the crowds saw what Paul had done, they started shouting in their own Lycaonian language, “The gods have become like men and have come down to us!”* (Acts 14:11)

- (i) What had Paul done? [1 mark]
- (ii) Give two further responses of the crowd. [2 marks]
- (iii) Later, Paul told the crowds about the living God. List two facts Paul mentioned about Him. [2 marks]

(d) *When Gallio was made the Roman governor of Achaia, the Jews got together, seized Paul, and took him into court.* (Acts 18:12)

- (i) Name the city where this event took place. [1 mark]
- (ii) What did the Jews accuse Paul of when they took him into the court? [1 mark]
- (iii) What is the response of Gallio to the Jews’ accusation? [2 marks]
- (iv) Finally, what did Gallio do to the Jews? [1 mark]
