Answer **all** questions.

1 (a) *But the angel said to him. “Don’t be afraid, Zechariah! God has heard your prayer, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son. You are to name him John.”* (Luke 1:13)

(i) Name the angel. [1 mark]

(ii) Where did the event take place? [1 mark]

(iii) Mention two things the angel said about John. [2 marks]

(iv) What was Zechariah’s response to the angel’s announcement? [1 mark]

(b) *You did not welcome me (Jesus) with a kiss, but **she** has not stopped kissing my feet since I came.* (Luke 7:45)

(i) Where did this conversation take place? [1 mark]

(ii) Other than kissing Jesus’ feet, what else did **she** do for Jesus? [2 marks]

(iii) What were Jesus’ comments on her actions? [2 marks]

(c) *He (Jesus) was going into a village when he was met by ten men suffering from a dreaded skin-disease.* (Luke 17:12a)

(i) What was the response of the ten men when they met Jesus? [1 mark]

(ii) Describe the way the ten men were healed from their dreaded skin-disease. [2 marks]

(iii) After they were healed, how did one of the ten men thank Jesus? [2 marks]

(d) *The whole **group** rose up and took Jesus before Pilate, where they began to accuse him.* (Luke 23:1-2a)

(i) Who were this **group** of people? [1 mark]

(ii) List three accusations brought against Jesus. [3 marks]

(iii) What did Pilate ask Jesus? [1 mark]

2 (a) *“How stubborn you (members of the Council) are!” Stephen went on to say. “How heathen your hearts, how deaf you are to God’s message! You are just like your ancestors; you too have always resisted the Holy Spirit!” (Acts 07:51)*

- (i) Give two characteristics of Stephen. [2 marks]
- (ii) State two other things Stephen said about members of the Council. [2 marks]
- (iii) In the end, what did the members of the Council do to Stephen? [1 mark]

(b) *Saul went to Jerusalem and tried to join the disciples. But they would not believe that he was a disciple, and they were all afraid of him. Then Barnabas came to his help and took him to the apostles. (Acts 09:26-27a)*

- (i) Where was Saul before he went to Jerusalem? [1 mark]
- (ii) Why were the disciples afraid of Saul? [2 marks]
- (iii) What did Barnabas say to the apostles to help Saul? [2 marks]

(c) *But the evil spirit said to **them**, “I know Jesus, and I know about Paul; but you- who are you?” (Acts 19:15)*

- (i) To whom was the evil spirit speaking? [1 mark]
- (ii) What was the immediate incident that led the spirit to say this? [2 marks]
- (iii) Finally, what happened to **them**? [2 marks]

(d) *After the men had gone a long time without food, Paul stood before them and said, “Men, you should have listened to me and not have sailed from Crete; then we would have avoided all this damage and loss. But now I beg you, take heart! Not one of you will lose his life; only the ship will be lost.” (Acts 27:21-22)*

- (i) The ship was hit by a strong wind. What is the name of that wind? [1 mark]
- (ii) State what Paul had seen and heard that gave him the confidence that not one of them would lose their lives. [3 marks]
- (iii) Name the island they arrived at after their ship was lost. [1 mark]

3 (a) Give an account of the sending out of the seventy two men by Jesus. [12 marks]

(b) From the incident, what was Jesus teaching these men? [3 marks]

4 (a) Narrate the parable of the Gold Coins. [13 marks]

(b) State a lesson from this parable. [2 marks]

5 (a) Relate Jesus' crucifixion at the place called "The Skull", including the response of the different groups of the people there. [13 marks]

(b) Comment on the significance of the curtain hanging in the temple being torn in two. [2 marks]

6 (a) Narrate the choosing of:

(i) the apostle to replace Judas Iscariot (exclude what was said about Judas Iscariot) [6 marks]

(ii) the seven helpers to be in charge of the distribution of funds [8 marks]

(b) State the significant event that led to the difference in the methods of choosing used on both occasions. [1 mark]

7 (a) Give an account of the healing of the man lame from birth at the Beautiful Gate. [11 marks]

(b) There was another incident where a man lame from birth was healed. Mention the place, name of the person who performed the miracle and the responses of the people to it. [4 marks]

8 (a) Narrate Paul's speech before the city council, the Areopagus, in Athens. [12 marks]

(b) Comment on the reactions of the city council members. [3 marks]
