1 (a) *“What about you?” he (Jesus) asked them (his disciples). “Who do you say that I am?” Peter answered, “You are God’s Messiah.” Then Jesus gave them strict orders not to tell this to anyone. (Luke 9:20-21)*

(i) Who did the crowds say Jesus was? [1 mark]

(ii) Why do you think Jesus gave them strict orders not to tell anyone that he was God’s Messiah? [2 marks]

(iii) State two prophecies Jesus made about himself to his disciples at this time. [2 marks]

(b) *Then Jesus said to his disciples, “And so I tell you not to worry about the food you need to stay alive or about the clothes you need for your body.” (Luke 12:22)*

(i) What did Jesus say in teaching his disciples not to worry about food and clothes? [2 marks]

(ii) Give examples from nature that Jesus used to prove his point. [2 marks]

(iii) Instead of worrying, what did Jesus want his disciples to do? [1 mark]

(c) *So Jesus stopped and ordered the blind man to be brought to him. When he came near, Jesus asked him, “What do you want me to do for you?” “Sir,” he answered, “I want to see again.” (Luke 18:40-41)*

(i) Where did this incident take place? [1 mark]

(ii) How did the blind man attract Jesus’ attention? [2 marks]

(iii) What did Jesus say in response to the blind man’s request to see again? [1 mark]

(iv) What does this miracle show us about Jesus? [1 mark]

(d) *Then he (Jesus) went off from them about the distance of a stone’s throw and knelt down and prayed, “Father,” he said, “if you will, take **this cup of suffering** away from me...” (Luke 22:41-42a)*

(i) Complete this prayer of Jesus. [1 mark]

(ii) Where was Jesus on this occasion? [1 mark]

(iii) What was Jesus strengthened after his prayer? [1 mark]

(iv) What did Jesus mean by **this cup of suffering**? [2 marks]

2 (a) *They still had their eyes fixed on the sky as **he** went away, when two men dressed in white suddenly stood beside them and said, “Galileans, why are you standing there looking at the sky?” (Acts 01:10-11a)*

(i) Who is **he**? [1 mark]

(ii) Name the place where this event happened. [1 mark]

(iii) What is the significance of this event? [2 marks]

(iv) What did the Galileans do immediately after this? [1 mark]

(b) *And then he (Gamaliel) said to the Council, “Fellow Israelites, be careful what you do to these men (apostles).” (Acts 05:35)*

(i) Who was Gamaliel? [1 mark]

(ii) What further advice did Gamaliel give the Council about the apostles? [2 marks]

(iii) How did his advice influence the Council’s decision? [2 marks]

(c) *As soon as Paul had this vision, we got ready to leave for Macedonia, ... (Acts 16:10a)*

(i) Where was Paul when he had this vision? [1 mark]

(ii) Describe the vision. [2 mark]

(iii) Explain the importance of this vision. [2 marks]

(d) *Five days later the High Priest Ananias went to Caesarea with some elders and a lawyer named Tertullus. They appeared before Felix and made their charges against Paul. (Acts 24:01)*

(i) A Roman commander had brought Paul to Governor Felix. Name this Roman commander. [1 mark]

(ii) Mention two of the charges Tertullus made against Paul. [2 marks]

(iii) What did Felix decide to do at the end of the hearing? [2 marks]

5 (a) Give an account of the discovery of the empty tomb on the resurrection morning. [10 marks]

(b) When Jesus appeared to the disciples in Jerusalem, what did he say and do to convince them that he was alive? [5 marks]

6 (a) Relate the account of the conversion of the Ethiopian eunuch by Philip. [13 marks]

(b) How did the Ethiopian eunuch's conversion impact the spread of the gospel? [2 marks]

7 (a) A riot broke out at Ephesus while Paul was there on his third missionary journey. Narrate:

(i) What Demetrius the silversmith said which led to the riot [6 marks]

(ii) What the city clerk said before dismissing the crowd [7 marks]

(b) What lesson can be learnt from this rioting incident? [2 marks]

8 (a) Give an account of Paul on the island of Malta after the shipwreck. [13 marks]

(b) Why was Paul not surprised to land safely on Malta? [2 marks]
